### Project Description

Trus Joist, now a division of Weyerhaeuser, built a Greenfield Timberstrand plant in Northwest Ontario.

### HGA Scope

HGA coordinated the engineering effort for the entire project. A total of five different consulting firms were involved in the project. HGA engineering management included the following critical areas:

#### Environmental Permitting

- Roughly 60 permits from 15 different agencies were required

#### Design, development, procurement, and monitoring of the following components

- Building ventilation and heating system
- All pneumatic systems
- Design of the wood processing system downstream of the core process

HGA also coordinated \$10 million in utility services for the plant.
