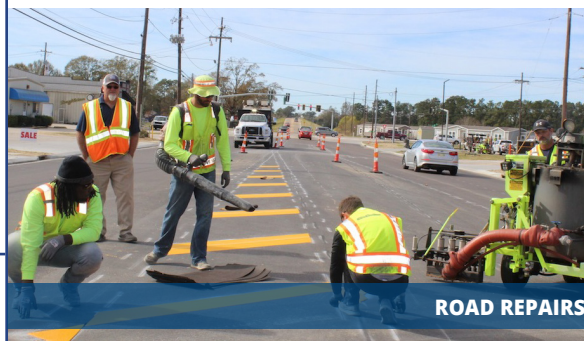

OVERVIEW

The State of Louisiana allocated much of its Hurricanes Gustav and Ike CDBG-DR funds to the impacted parishes for housing, infrastructure, and economic development projects. Tangipahoa Parish procured HGA to help administer its CDBG-DR allocation.

SOLUTION

HGA has administered infrastructure and public facility projects that have provided economic revitalization for Tangipahoa Parish. The services include the development of parish recovery plans that detail projects crucial for the parish's recovery, initial planning for each of these projects; interaction with key stakeholders; CDBG application development; preparation of environmental review records; standard right-of-way acquisitions; conducting public hearings; labor compliance; and overall grant management through every phase of each project. HGA uses tools such as schedules, needs lists, and progress reporting to keep Parish administrators actively involved in the work and informed of its status. Projects include improving roads, upgrading buildings, a new events center, and rebuilding rail spurs.
