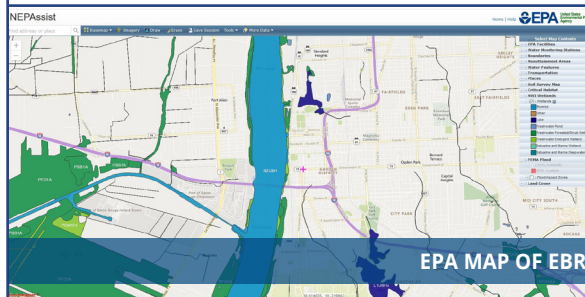

HGA provides technical assistance to ensure compliance with the City-Parish's policies and the federal regulations surrounding these HUD funding sources, to include the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, CDBG-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program, HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program, and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program, as well as Coronavirus response funding (e.g., CDBG-CV, ESG-CV, HOPWA-CV).
